Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons why financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Castle chooses to share personal information and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Castle Financial protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that we believe comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. How does Castle collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Enter into an agreement with us Seek financial advice Make deposits or withdrawals from your account Tell us about your portfolio/investments Provide us with your employment history, account statements and other personal information for us to manage your accounts and offer financial advice.
	We also collect your personal information from others such as other financial institutions, Broker- dealers/Custodians that you have authorized us to receive information from.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only: Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness (Which we do not provide) Affiliates from using your information to market to you Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you (We do not share for marketing purposes) State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account, I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions					
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.				
Non-Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Non-affiliates we may share information with include an independent representative's new brokerage or an investment advisory firm. 				
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliates financial companies that together market financial products or services to you: This may include banks, credit unions or other financial institutions with which we have a joint marketing agreement
